Snow Ordinance Towing

On Thursday, February 8th, 2018, at approximately 07:00 am, the Bradley Police, in cooperation with the Bradley Department of Public Works, will begin enforcing the Village Snow Ordinance for the removal of vehicles on the street for snow removal. Plow crews will be starting from Kennedy Dr and working their way Eastbound through the Village.

It is imperative that we can get the streets cleared in preparation for the heavy snows forecasted for this weekend.

We ask all residents to move any vehicle which may restrict plow access in order to clear the street. Police Officers will also attempt to make contact with vehicles in violation, however, those vehicles remaining may be removed pursuant the Village Snow Ordinance. (Attached).

Snow Removal—Sec. 52-139(b)

No motor vehicle shall be parked or be allowed to remain parked after a snowfall of three or more inches on any north-south streets or any street in a subdivision where driveways are available for the parking of such vehicles until such street has been plowed. After adjacent north-south streets have been plowed in such a storm event, no motor vehicle shall be parked or be allowed to remain parked on an east-west street until after such east-west street has been plowed. Any motor vehicle parked or allowed to remain parked in violation of this section shall be considered a hazard to traffic and a public nuisance and may be removed by an authorized towing service designated by the police department and such towing and storage shall be at the owner's expense. In addition thereto, the owner shall be subject to a fine as provided in the general penalty provision in section 1-6.
