- ★ Voting by mail begins Sept. 27, 2018
- ★ No excuse is needed to vote by mail  
Any Person Registered to Vote can Vote by Mail!

## Grace Period Registration

Beginning October 10, qualified individuals can register to vote or update their registration at any Early Voting location .

## Do I need an ID to vote?

No ID is required if you are already registered to vote. However, it will speed up the voting process if you let the Election Judge scan your driver's license at your polling location.
