**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT WITH THE
NATIONAL JOINT POWERS ALLIANCE**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1, *et. seq.*) empower the Village and other governmental entities to obtain or share services and to exercise, combine, or transfer any power or function not prohibited by any law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the National Joint Powers Alliance (“NJPA”) is a Municipal Agency (*i.e.* a unit of local government) under the laws of the State of Minnesota and is therefore authorized, along with the Village, to obtain or share services and to exercise, combine, or transfer any power or function not prohibited by any law or ordinance (*see* Ill. Const. Art. VII §10; *see also* 5 ILCS 220/1, *et. seq.*); and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to become a participating member of the NJPA pursuant to a Joint Powers Agreement (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, Village participation in the NJPA will enable the Village to purchase products and services using the advantages of joint contract purchasing; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that Village participation in the NJPA is in the best interests of the Village and its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The President and Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The President and Board of Trustees of the Village hereby adopt the Agreement, which is attached hereto as exhibit A and fully incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. The Village President is hereby authorized and directed, in his capacity as such President, to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Village.

SECTION 4. The Village President is further authorized and directed to take any other action and execute other any document necessary to make the Village a participating member of the NJPA.

SECTION 5. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 6. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 7. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

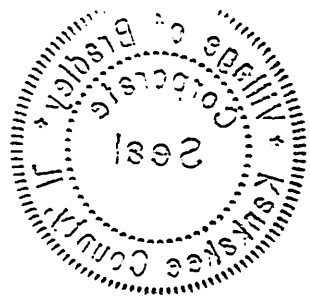
