ORDINANCE NO. O-6-19-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER O-5-19-4

WHEREAS, the Trustees of Village of Bradley previously passed and approved Ordinance Number O-5-19-4 :and,

WHEREAS, the Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village of

Bradley, and those businesses impacted by the Hotel Operator's Occupation Tax located within the municipal boundaries of the Village of Bradley to delay the implementation of the tax authorized by Ordinance Number O-5-19-4 for a period of one month from the date previously approved by the Trustees; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Code of Ordinances currently authorizes the implementation of said tax on Hotels located within the municipal boundaries of the Village of Bradley to begin on July 1, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. RECITALS.

That the foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

SECTION 2 .HOTEL OPERATOR'S OCCUPATIONAL TAX AMENDMENT.

Section 2-201 of the Village of Bradley Code of Ordinances ("Preparation of Ordinances") shall be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows (additions **underlined in bold**, deletions marked with ~~strikethrough~~):

§ 12-252 – TAX IMPOSED; EXEMPTION:

- A. There is hereby imposed a tax upon all persons engaged in the rental or leasing of any rooms in a hotel within the corporate boundaries of the Village at a rate of five percent (5%) of gross rental or leasing receipts, which tax shall begin to accrue on ~~July 1, 2019~~ **August 1, 2019**, and shall thereafter be collected pursuant to this Article.

SECTION 5. RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTS.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. SAVING CLAUSE.

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance, which are hereby declared to be separable.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVENESS.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.

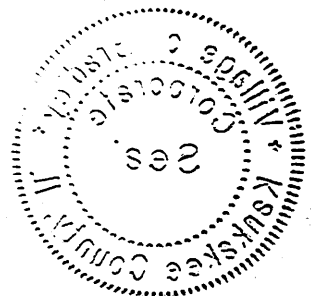
